

Garnishments & Levies: Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Why was money withdrawn from my account?

A: We received an order from the court. You should contact the court for further information.

Q: Don't you need my permission to take money from my account?

A: When we receive a garnishment, we are legally obligated to comply with the court order.

Q: What is going to happen to the items that haven't cleared my account?

A: Just like you, we were not aware of the garnishment until we received the court order. We would advise you to contact these billers to discuss your options.

Q: Will any more deposits be taken from my account?

A: We are only required to hold funds on deposit at the time the garnishment is received.

Q: How can I dispute this garnishment/levy?

A: Review your garnishment/levy form for instructions on how to file a dispute.
